S. Government, the Vatican and the International Red Cross, and his settlement in Bolivia with his wife Regine and two children. His nefarious past exemplifies Collective and Personal Evil that is also addressed in this book. The Devils Agent goes deep into Barbies life in Bolivia and relays information that has never been written about, as some of his closest allies...
