The present volume gives in full the methods and estimates on which the results shown in the first volume are based. In addition, it goes into many details concerning particular industries. While the Summary Volume was a joint product of the Staff of the National Bureau of Economic Research, the detailed estimates now presented are primarily the work of three individuals. Mr. King is responsible for the estimate of the National Income based on the value product of different industries; Mr. Knauth made the estimate based on incomes received by individuals; and Mr. Macaulay undertook the discussion of the problem of the distribution of income by income-classes. Unity was preserved by means of many consultations, and the whole book was edited by Mr. Mitchell. Like all the Bureau s publications,...
