

The book is intended primarily for use as a text in a two or threehour course in roads and pavements, but numerous tables and typical designs and specifications have been included that should add to its value as a reference book for highway engineers. The ultimate object of all highway engineering is the construction of durable and well-designed roadway surfaces. The attainment of this object involves selecting and testing the materials, assembling those that are suitable, and incorporating them in the roadway surface. A knowledge of the construction of roads and pavements is therefore the basis of highway engineering. Much of the material used in the text has been prepared from notes that have been accumulating for several years. Diming that time the author has attended numerous conventions of highway engineers and has often discussed the various problems...
