V. O Shea. The first step toward organization was taken at the Summer School Congresses held at the University in August, 1895, when a committee consisting of Prof. L. H. Galbreath, Supt. S. S. Parr and Miss Marietta L. Pierce was appointed to prepare a constitution. The organization was effected at the holiday meeting of the State Educational Association by the adoption of the constitution reported by the committee and by the election of officers. About 80 persons joined at this meeting and as many more during the year 1896. A very few have withdrawn from the Association and a number have joined this year (1897). The first Secretary-Treasurer of the Association, L. H. Galbreath, before he left the State, in June, 1896, sent out eight communications to members treating of the following topics: Communication I., Child Study Literature:...
